#### FAFSA -Free Application for Federal Student Aid.

The federal government uses this form to determine your eligibility for financial aid. The Dept. of Education uses the Federal Methodology (FM) to calculate your aid eligibility.

**ALL colleges require the FAFSA** form for financial aid. Most deadlines will be met if financial aid forms are mailed by mid -February, but be **sure** to check with your college.
