Pens and pencils



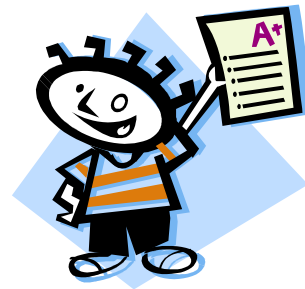
Recommended: Assignment book / calendar

II. Grading

The semester grade is developed in the following way:

Grade weights: Homework/Projects 40%
Tests/Quizzes 60%

Homework: * May be done in pen or pencil.
* Will be collected at the end of each unit or is due on dates specified by the instructor.

Tests: * May be done in pencil.
* Cannot be retaken unless deemed necessary by the instructor

Final Exam: A comprehensive final exam will be given at the end of the semester. It will be counted as approximately two test scores and will be averaged into the “test” portion of the final grade.

III. Calculator Use

Students are strongly encouraged to use the TI-82 graphing calculator. Other TI graphing models will work as well. Calculators will be used to make arithmetic faster and more accurate. Calculator use will be taught. However, every lesson will be taught so that the student is capable of doing the assignment without the use of the calculator.

- * Be organized – keep all papers and notes in a three-ring binder – students will be given points for a completed notebook at the end of the semester.
 - * Do homework at all times and on – test questions come from the homework assignments.
 - * Always show work – even when using the calculator.
 - * Set up times to get extra help if needed.
