

Denver Lutheran High School / Lutheran High School Parker Referral Program



Dear parents of current students and parents of incoming freshmen,

We would like to present you with a unique way to lower your tuition AND serve the greater good of our high schools.

We have created a "referral contact form." You can approach interested families that have 5th-8th grade children and want to know more about our Lutheran High Schools. They can fill out the form, giving consent to us to contact them by mail, phone, and/or email.

For every completed form that you turn in to the high school, we will discount your yearly tuition \$50. The cap on forms per LHS student is 20 (\$1000). \$250 will be discounted if that referral is an 8th grader and attends one of our GrowingInHIM tours before June 30, 2010.

Some parameters:

- Referrals must be for families that have a 5th, 6th, 7th, or 8th grader (09-10 school year).
- Only one referral form can be used per prospective family. A family with 8th grade triplets and 6th grade twins counts once, not five times.
- Prospective families with students that attend the Lutheran elementary schools or the LCMS Lutheran confirmation classes are not eligible (we already get their contact information).
- Prospective students who have submitted their contact information through our websites are not eligible.
- Once a referral form for a prospective family has been turned in, that family cannot be used again (first come, first serve).
- Students/families that are already in high school should not be targeted with this program (CHSAA recruitment rules, ethical considerations, etc.). If a family of a current high school student shows interest, they should be referred directly to the school admissions number or the principal. We do appreciate these referrals as well, but we cannot actively seek them.
- The deadline for turning in referral forms is **June 30, 2010**. The Admissions Director will track the forms and determine whether they meet the criteria above.

The "spirit" of this program should be considered at all times. The goal is to enlarge our base of prospective students and parents. Referral forms for families that have no interest whatsoever in learning more about our Lutheran High Schools (but you talked them in to signing the form to benefit financially) would be counted but do not match the "spirit" of the program. The Admissions Director reserves the right to not "count" a referral for appropriate reasons not listed above.

We hope you'll take this opportunity to market your high school by word of mouth and take advantage of the opportunity to save on tuition expense.
